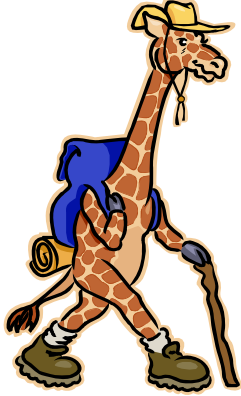

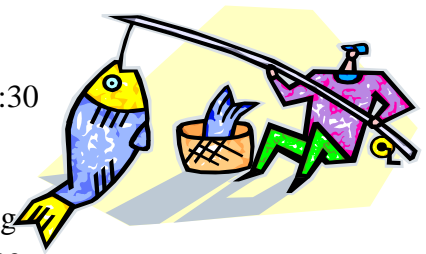

Ranger Kids Meetings & Activities



The Ranger year begins in September. We meet together with the other Royal Ranger groups at Parkview School on Wednesday evenings from 6:30 pm to 8:00 pm. During these meetings, you will complete most of the advancement requirements, including the memory verses, before June. During June and July, we will meet at church in the garage. We will make walking sticks; go hiking and fishing; and participate in other outdoor games and activities.



We do not have regular Wednesday evening meetings in August.

Uniforms



You are encouraged to purchase a vest and Ranger T-shirt. The uniform shows that you are a part of Royal Rangers and are a great way to display your accomplishments during journey in Ranger Kids. The vests are blue denim, and you will wear this vest through 2nd grade, so you may want to purchase a slightly larger size.

The cost of the vest is \$13.00 (including patches) and the Ranger T-shirts are \$8.

Pinewood Derby



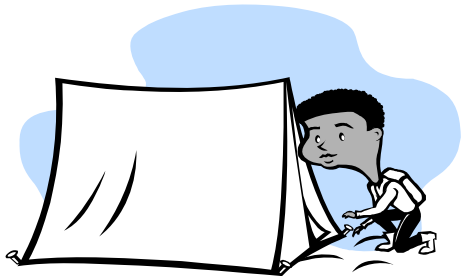
Our Ranger Outpost runs a Pinewood Derby at church in March.

Ranger Kids Camp

In addition to camping in tents, we also go swimming, and have a fun competition event with prizes. All boys starting kindergarten in the fall through 3rd grade are welcome to attend. Information for this camp is distributed at the end of June. The cost of this camp is \$55.00 for each person.
